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## Meeting Minutes for June 21, 2017

### Old Business:

- **Update Council on trucking and transportation issues in the County.** Deputy Brad Tomasheski said Route 23 near Coral Road was experiencing an increase in gravel truck traffic and local residents have been expressing concern.
- **Update on mine reclamation progress at closed pit in McHenry County.** Darrell Moore said the Linden Lakes mine is in the process of being reclaimed so that the bond may be returned to the owners. Co-owners submitted a revised plan to the County in April that was approved by County Planning and Development Commission that includes developing a wetland and two-acre industrial pad, possibly for a trucking operation. Currently moving topsoil from adjacent land and is being graded.

### New Business:

- **Any developing issues?**
  - **Darrell Moore** said the County still needs to issue licenses and inspect pits next month.
  - **Scott Kuykendall** said his office will be studying the county's water resources and will be compiling data from wells overseen by the county, USGS and ISGS. Discussion continued

regarding permitted Clean Construction Demolition Debris and Uncontaminated Soil Fill sites.

- County is still getting calls about truck traffic near the entrance to the gravel pit on Foster Road. **Deputy Brad Tomasheski** said local residents were asked to take a picture of trucks in question so that the Sheriff's office could determine if the trucks were coming out of the pit or the business across the street. Pictures have been inconclusive so far.
